Cains had *Styrian Gold* which was very light for a Cains beer but was very pleasing to the taste, but the beer that take the current honour is Moorhouses *Black Panther* this 4.9% beer which was a special brew was so well received from all drinkers for its full bodied and smooth taste that it would follow *Black Cat* to win another award for this popular Burnley brewery.
